Coastline Community College was founded in 1976 to meet the educational needs of adult learners. In addition to its classroom-based vocational and academic programs, the college has pioneered the use of educational technology through the design, production, and delivery of Emmy award-winning telecourses, live cable-delivered classes, and interactive videoconferencing, online and CDROM delivered instruction. The college has extensive facilities to support the design and delivery of technology-mediated instruction, including an Instructional Resources Center, a cable origination center, and a technology-enhanced learning center that includes lecture halls and classrooms from which videoconferencing and cablecasts can originate. The latter is currently used to deliver live cable classes that are simultaneously video-streamed over the Internet. During 2008/09 Coastline completed 7000 SOCNAV agreements in support of Sailors enrolled in the NCPDLP and NCPACE, with 1600 degrees awarded. Total military enrollment exceeded 27,000.

Coastline Community College is regionally accredited by WASC-Jr., the Western Association of Schools and Colleges/Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges.

Coastline Prerequisites and ASSET Placement Scores

MATH 010 - ELEMENTARY ALGEBRA

PREREQUISITE: One of the following:

- Score 39 or higher on the ASSET Numerical Skills Test
- Score 31-40 on the ASSET Elementary Algebra Test
- Qualifying score on Coastline's Math Placement Test

MATH 030 – INTERMEDIATE ALGEBRA

PREREQUISITE: One of the following

- Math 010 (elementary algebra) with grade of “C” or better
- Score 41 or higher on the ASSET Elementary Algebra Test
- Score 31 or higher on the ASSET Intermediate Algebra Test
- Qualifying score on Coastline's Math Placement Test

MATH 100 - QUANTITATIVE REASONING

PREREQUISITE: One of the following:

- Math 030 (intermediate algebra) with a “C” or better
- Score 35 or higher on the ASSET Intermediate Algebra Test
- Qualifying score on Coastline's Math Placement Test

MATH 115 – COLLEGE ALGEBRA

PREREQUISITE: One of the following:

- Math 030 (intermediate algebra) with a “C” or better
- Score 35 or higher on the ASSET Intermediate Algebra Test.
- Qualifying score on Coastline's Math Placement Test

Math Competency for an Option 1 AA degree at Coastline may be earned in any one of the following ways:

Score or 35 or higher on the ASSET Intermediate Algebra Test
or completing two years of high school algebra with grade of “C” or better
or passing an Intermediate Algebra or higher level math course at Coastline or another college with grade of “C” or better
or Military ratings that include college algebra or higher
